

Judging Sport Horse Conformation Class

Participants do not need a horse in order to enter this class. Class will be scored on how closely the competitor's scores come to the scores of the appointed judge.

Participants will join our appointed judge at the triangle. The Judge will evaluate one horse and the marks will be told to all competitors, so the competitors will have an example of how the judge will score the horses. Then three horses will be brought out and judged by the judge(s) and the competitors on a 1 - 10 scale as in the regular dressage tests. The competitor's scores which most closely match the judges' scores will be the winner.
